### Concert series at SPJC



# Long-standing relationship with SPJC

St. Petersburg Junior College conferred honorary degrees upon Anatoly Sobchak (deceased mayor of St. Petersburg,

Russia) and Yuri Ushakov, the present Russian Ambassador to the United States. The Rev. Igor Chitikov (rector of St. Andrew's Russian Orthodox church) has given the invocation and benediction for two graduation ceremonies at the college this year. SPJC provides English as a Second Language (ESL) courses to more than 30 Russian students and this course at SPJC is considered among the best in the

United States. President Carl Kuttler was commissioned by the U.S. State Department a few years ago to study the establishment of junior colleges in Russia. Over the past 10 years, he has collected Russian icons, Matryoshka dolls and other Russian objects. Some of this collection will be exhibited at the Russian Cultural Center adjacent to the new Music

Center. This is the project that Russian Heritage supported with a contribution to St. Petersburg Junior College last year. We are deeply appreciative of the help given our organization by the president and staff of SPJC.
